

Within the Macmillan Day Care Centre my remit covers – patient referral to the centre - each patient receives an initial assessment where general nurse –based goals and more specific physiotherapy based goals are set. Each patient then receives 12 weeks of rehabilitation where at the end they are re-assessed and then if the goals are met then they are referred onto community care where they can continue with their goals. If they do not reach the goals within the 12 weeks then they are kept on for another 12 weeks. Cancer patients are not discharged they are kept on. The ultimate aim is to try to keep the patient at home.
